

CCAI Ukraine Adoption Program Fees

For Families in Colorado

CCAI is proud to be a 501(c)(3) non-profit, charitable adoption agency. That means we are financially accountable to you as the American public and as an adoptive family. Disclosing all costs up front and having no hidden charges is important to us. While providing uncompromised first-class adoption service, CCAI's fees are among the lowest fees in the field of Ukraine adoption.

Once your application is approved, you will sign a Fee Policy/Agreement (see "Sample Fee Policy Agreement") with CCAI which commits you to pay: 1) CCAI fees and 2) expenses paid to other entities necessary to complete your adoption (see "Adoption Expenses by Chronology"). **The Fee Policy/Agreement also commits CCAI to not change the amount of our fees throughout your adoption.**

Families make CCAI fee payments three different times and only when they are ready to be provided with the services covered by that fee. Following is a breakdown of the services covered by each of CCAI's fees.

*Fees listed are for both parents traveling to finalize the adoption in Ukraine. Should only one of the two parents travel to finalize the adoption in Ukraine, there will be additional fees to cover additional state mandated post adoption reports until the adoption is finalized in Colorado.

If only one parent traveled to complete the adoption, your child will arrive home on an IR-4 Visa. After re-adoption, adoptive parents must file the N-600 to apply for your child(ren)'s Certificate of Citizenship through U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS). Upon receipt of a photocopy of Ukraine Adoption Decree and Birth Certificate, CO Birth Certificate, US Issued Adoption Decree, the Certificate of Citizenship, and 1st year post adoption report submitted at the Ukraine Consulate, the deposit will be refunded to the family.
