

Ukraine Adoption Expenses by Chronology

For Families in Colorado

The cost of your Ukraine adoption will consist of both CCAI Service Fees and expenses paid to outside agencies for their services. One of the many benefits of CCAI's Ukraine adoption program is that the costs are clearly defined from the moment you begin your adoption journey. The adoption fees and costs are spread out over the course of the entire adoption process. Expenses paid to CCAI throughout the adoption (highlighted in **BOLD** below) will be about one fourth of the overall adoption expenses. Below we have listed each expense necessary to complete your adoption, to whom it is paid, and when it is due. Each expense is identified by the **Key** and detailed in "Explanation of Non-CCAI Expenses."

† When you provide a check as payment, you authorize CCAI either to use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction. When we use information from your check to make an electronic fund transfer, funds may be withdrawn from your account as soon as the same day we receive your payment, and you will not receive your check back from your financial institution.

** In-country fees are subject to an additional 1%-6% Ukraine bank fee, depending on facilitator's financial institution.

NOTE: If only one parent travels to Ukraine to complete the adoption, your child will arrive home on an IR-4 visa and will only receive a Permanent Resident Card, NOT US citizenship. After re-adoption, adoptive parents must apply for a Certificate of Citizenship through USCIS.
